**SAFETY ENFORCEMENT CRITERIA**

Violation of the following codes of conduct, state law, or any other conduct detrimental to the safety of other users of Bridger Bowl facilities by the participant or coach named above may result in the loss of: all skiing privileges at Bridger Bowl, participation in programs or events offered by the Bridger Ski Foundation conducted at Bridger Bowl, and the loss of season pass or lift ticket without compensation. This includes but is not limited to: United States Skiing Association Code of Conduct, "Your Responsibility Code," Bridger Bowl Inc. Mountain Regulations, Bridger Ski Foundation Code of Conduct and Montana State Law, sections 23-2-736, 23-2-704 and 23-2-735. The following is a partial list of infractions and penalties:

**Suspension**

- Reckless Skiing.
- Disorderly Conduct.
- Abusive Language.
- Intoxication, Drug Use.
- Disregard of Area Regulations.
- Excessive Speed.
- Skiing under Rope Lines.
- Skiing fast in Slow Areas
- Failure to Use Appropriate Retention Devices

**Expulsion**

- Repeat Offenders.
- Improper Embarking or Disembarking from Ski Lift.
- Reckless Skiing resulting in Injury or Collision.
- Vandalism.
- Blatant disregard of Area Regulations.
- Fighting.
- Skiing in a Closed Area.
- Crossing the Area Boundary.
- Endangering the life and safety of other persons riding a chairlift or causing damage to a chairlift.

**WARNING, NOTIFICATION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT**

I hereby voluntarily request to participate or to have my minor child participate in Bridger Ski Foundation's Racing Program conducted at Bridger Bowl. I understand that skiing and racing in it's various forms, as well as preparation for participation in, coaching, volunteering, officiating and related activities in alpine and freestyle competitions and clinics (hereinafter referred to as "Activities"), includes inherent dangers and risks that are part of the sport including: changing weather conditions; snow conditions as they exist or as they may change, including ice, hardpack, powder, packed powder, wind pack, corn snow, crust, slush, cut-up snow, and machine-made snow; avalanches, except on open, designated ski trails; collisions with natural surface or subsurface conditions, such as bare spots, forest growth, rocks, stumps, streambeds, cliffs, trees, and other natural objects; collisions with lift towers, signs, posts, fences, enclosures, hydrants, waterpipes, or other artificial structures and their components; variations in steepness or terrain, whether natural or the result of slope design, snowmaking, or snow grooming operations, including but not limited to roads, freestyle terrain, ski jumps, catwalks and other terrain modifications; collisions with clearly visible or plainly marked equipment, including but not limited to lift equipment, snowmaking equipment, snow grooming equipment, trail maintenance equipment and snowmobiles, whether or not the equipment is moving; collisions with other skiers; the failure of a skier to ski within that skier's ability; skiing in a closed area or skiing outside the ski area boundary as designated on the ski area trail map; and restricted visibility caused by snow, wind, fog, sun, or darkness. I agree to visually and physically inspect the course and the adjacent area before using the course for any training, practice or competition. Fencing, equipment covers, signs, rope lines and other devices may be in place and mark some, but not all of the potential obstacles or hazards. These markers will not prevent injury. I understand it is my/my child's responsibility to stay away from marked areas. I acknowledge the existence of these risks and accept such risks, on behalf of myself and/or my minor child, whether they are marked or unmarked. I understand that injuries of all types are a common and ordinary occurrence of the Activities. I know that the risk of severe injury or death exists in all training and competition locations and Activities, including free skiing and riding, and I voluntarily accept such risks on behalf of myself or my minor child. I am aware and understand that the Bridger Ski Foundation is solely responsible for all decisions pertaining to the operation of it's racing/training program including but not limited to: the condition of the course and adjacent areas; setting of courses; all coaching and training; safety measures, including fencing, padding, personnel management and other precautions necessary to conduct racing and training operations according to USSA and/or FIS guidelines.

ON BEHALF OF MYSELF AND/OR MY MINOR CHILD, I HEREBY RELEASE, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY BRIDGER BOWL INC., ITS EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY FOR PERSONAL INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE RESULTING FROM THE RISKS DESCRIBED HEREIN, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER SUCH RISKS RESULT FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF BRIDGER BOWL INC., ITS EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS
